Fund Objective

The Herald Worldwide Technology Fund (HWTF) is an Open Ended Investment Company (OEIC) that seeks to achieve capital growth, in excess of the average, by investing in quoted companies in the technology, communications and multi-media sectors. As its name suggests, the Fund invests in companies worldwide, but especially North America and the UK.

Fund Manager Comment

Performance in the month

March saw further upward momentum in all regions except the UK. The North American stocks returned 5.8%. Apple, Amazon and Microsoft were all strong, and Mellanox Technologies has been conducting a sale process, which culminated in a bid from Nvidia at \$125 per share. The Asian and European stocks also appreciated on average by 6.4%. SAP led the European growth (+9.8%), but Ctrip in Asia was the best performer in the whole Fund (+30.4%). In the UK, Avast was weak reflecting the placing of VC stock. We have travelled extensively in March and met >250 companies, predominantly outside of the UK, and feel reassured that the companies continue to trade well in a dynamic sector, in spite of political turbulence in a number of places.

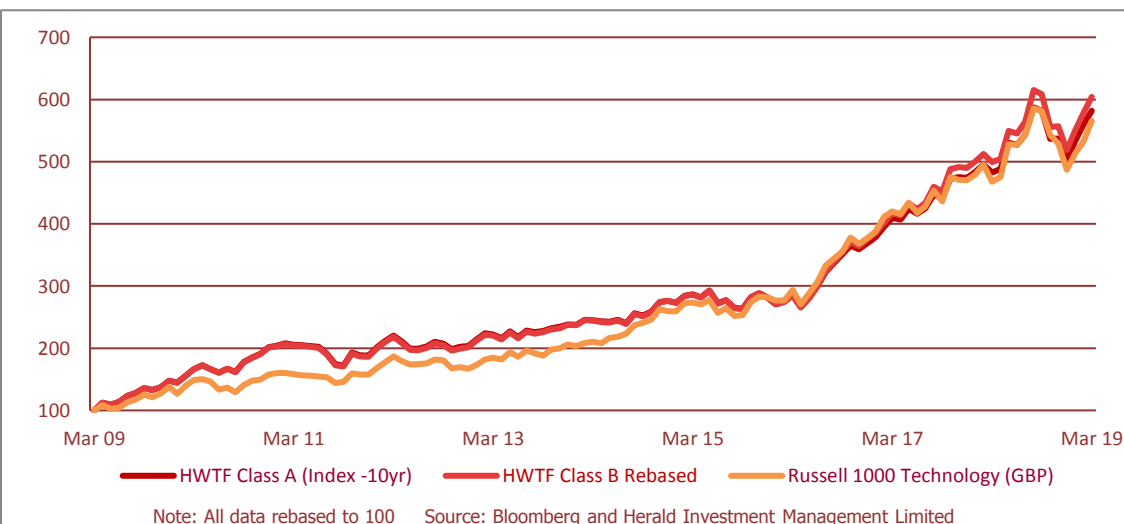

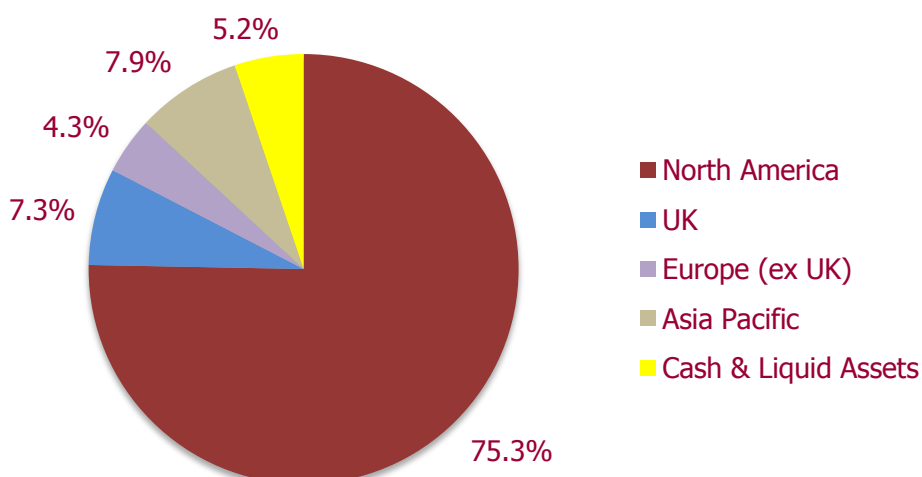
